BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED that the following binding referendum be placed on the Student Senate election ballot on March 6, 7, 8 and 9, 2000:

"We, the students of the University of Wisconsin-Eau Claire, agree to support an increase in segregated fees up to \$38.00 per student, per semester, to begin by the fall of 2001 and to be phased in over a period of three years to support a project of up to approximately \$8.5 million to expand and renovate Davies Center. This project would include approximately 41,500 square feet of expansion potentially designed for, but not limited to, the following examples: additional dining areas, a bank/credit union, a broadcast area for the Student Radio Initiative, an expanded Cabin/club-style performance space, a fitness center, a food court, a larger Equality Resource Center, more lounge/study space, more meeting space, more retail space, more student organization cubicles and space, a self-care cold clinic, and a tenant information center."

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that students be given the choice of answering "yes" or "no" to the above referendum.
